

# Cookie Policy

1. This document illustrates the cookie policy of the website [www.hecchino-dal-1887.com](http://www.hecchino-dal-1887.com) In particular, it explains what cookies are, how they are used by the website and what options are given to the user to manage them.

This document is an integral part of the Privacy Policy of the website [www.hecchino-dal-1887.com](http://www.hecchino-dal-1887.com) how and the information contained therein provided to the interested parties pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation, EU Regulation no. 679/2016, the code regarding the protection of personal data, Legislative Decree of 30 June 1993, no. 196 and subsequent amendments, and the "Guidelines for cookies and other tracking tools - 10 June 2021", Official Journal no. 163 of 9 July 2021. 3. The information is provided only for cookies present within the site and not for those of external sites reachable through links present within the site itself.
4. This document may be periodically updated, therefore it is recommended to read it every time you connect so that you are properly informed.

## What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on the user's device (computer, tablet, smartphone) when he visits the website.

Cookies do not record any personal information and any identifiable data will not be stored. If you wish, you can prevent the saving of some or all cookies.

However, in this case the use of the site and the services offered could be compromised. To proceed without changing the options relating to cookies, simply continue browsing.

This website may use, also in combination with each other, the following types of cookies classified according to the indications of the Privacy Guarantor and the Opinions issued in the European context by the Working Group

pursuant to art. 29 of the GDPR:

1. **Session**, are cookies that are not stored persistently on the user's computer and are deleted when the browser is closed, they are strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers necessary to allow safe and efficient exploration of the site.

2. **Persistent** cookies are those that remain stored on your computer's hard drive until upon their expiration or cancellation by users/visitors. Through persistent cookies, visitors who access the site (or any other users who use the same computer) are automatically recognized at each visit.

Visitors can set their computer browser to accept/refuse all cookies or to display a warning each time a cookie is proposed, in order to evaluate whether to accept it or not. By setting the highest level of protection on their browser, the user can

disable and block them.

Cookies are used for various purposes, such as:

- **Technical cookies:** necessary for the correct functioning of the website (for example, to maintain the browsing session, choose the language). For this type in general it is not required to acquire prior consent
- **Analytical cookies:** used to collect information on the use of the website (for example, the number of visitors, the most visited pages). Sometimes they can be associated with other information such as credentials for access to restricted areas, but not in our case.
- **Profiling cookies:** used to create user profiles and display personalized advertising. They are further divided into:
  1. **Widgets**, this category includes all those graphic components of a program's user interface, which have the purpose of facilitating the user in interacting with the program itself. By way of example, widgets are META cookies.
  2. **Advertising**, this category includes cookies used to advertise within a site. Google, Tradedoubler fall into this category
  3. **Third-party cookies:** In relation to their origin, cookies sent to the computer's browser from other sites and not from the one you are visiting are distinguished. Most third-party cookies are tracking cookies used to identify online behavior, understand interests and therefore customize advertising proposals for users.

## How do we use cookies?

We use the following types of cookies on our website:

- **Technical cookies:** These cookies are essential for the functioning of the website. Without them, some features may not be available.
- **Analytical cookies:** We use these cookies to analyse how users interact with our website. This information helps us to improve the website and the user experience.
- **Profiling cookies:** We do not use cookies to show you personalized advertising based on your interests.
- **Third-party cookies:** Our website may use third-party cookies, such as those from Google Analytics or social media.

These cookies are subject to the privacy policies of the respective third parties.

## Cookie management

On your first visit to our Site, you can accept all cookies by clicking on the “OK” button or the “X” (close) button on a popup.

For all subsequent visits, you can change your preferences at any time by accessing a banner by clicking on the button provided specifically for this purpose, from which you can access our information and change your choices regarding consent

to the installation of cookies.

Additionally, you can change your cookie settings directly in your browser. Most browsers allow you to:

- **View** the cookies present on your device.
- **Delete** cookies.
- **Block** cookies.

- **Set preferences** for cookies for specific websites.

Please note that disabling some cookies may affect your browsing experience on the website.
